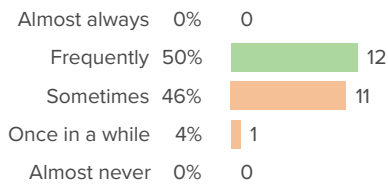

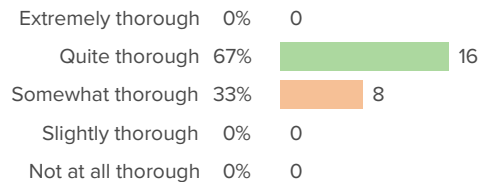

Q.1: How often do you receive feedback on your teaching?



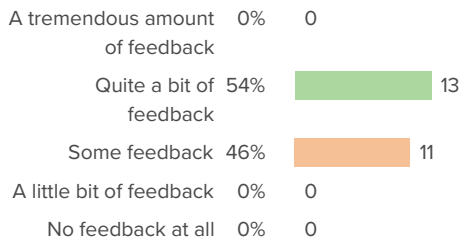

Q.2: At your school, how thorough is the feedback you receive in covering all aspects of your role as a teacher?



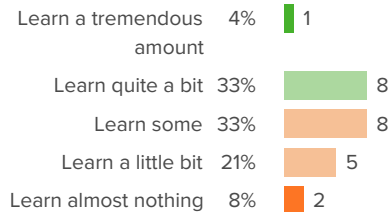

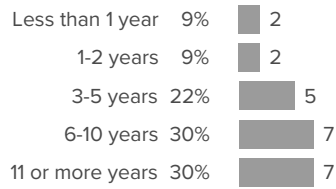

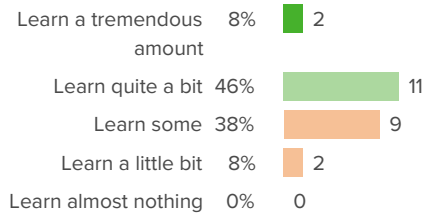

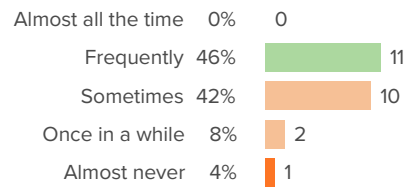
How did people respond?

Q.1: Overall, how much do you learn about teaching from the leaders at your school?



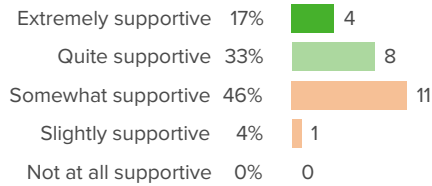

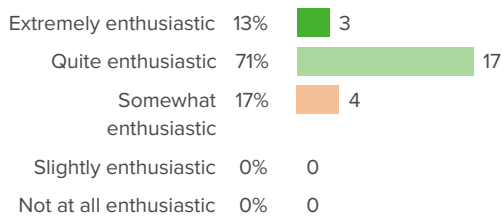

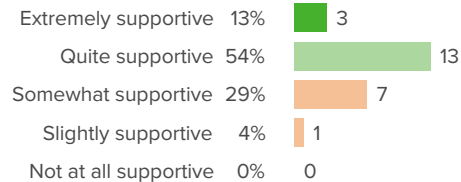

Q.1: On most days, how enthusiastic are the students about being at school?



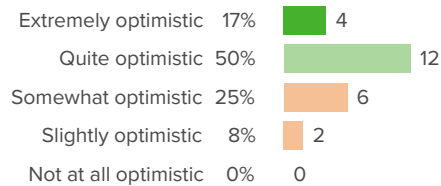

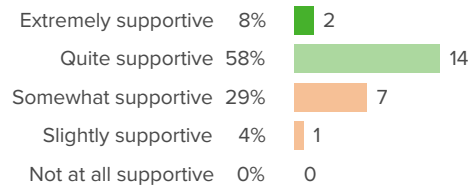

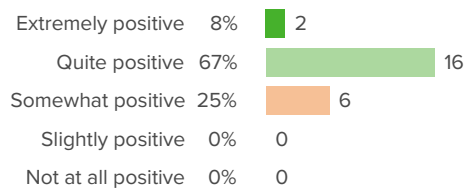

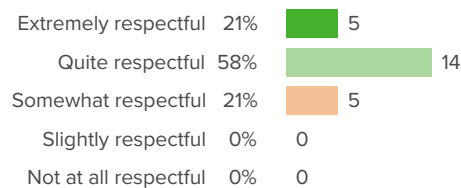

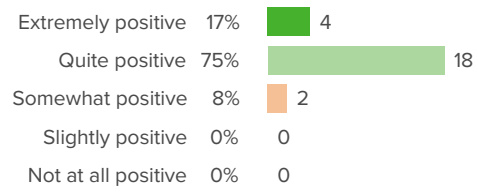

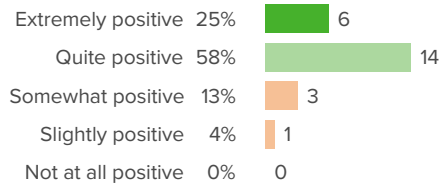

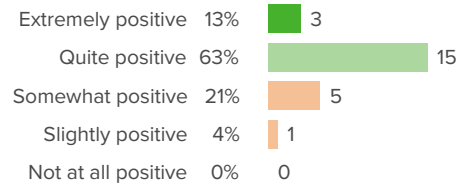

Q.1: How positive is the tone that school leaders set for the culture of the school?



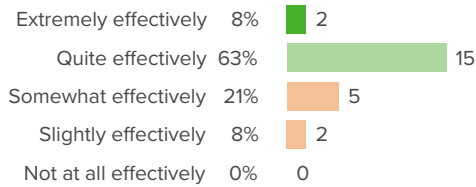

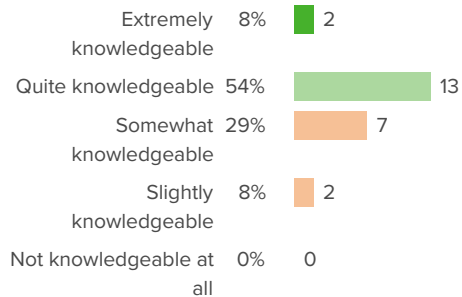

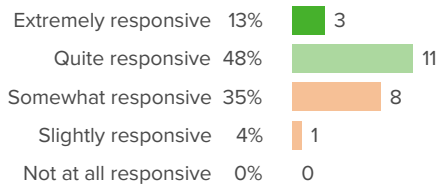

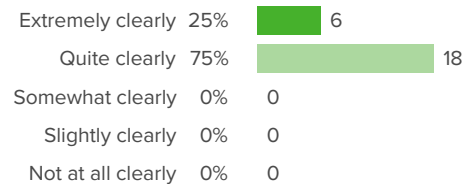

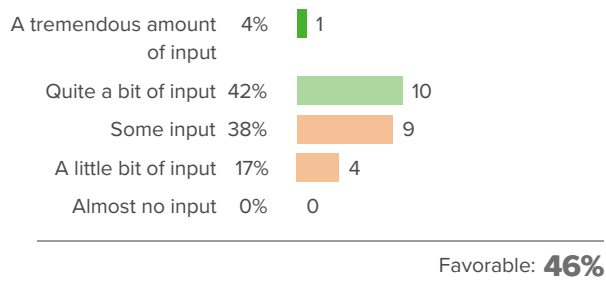

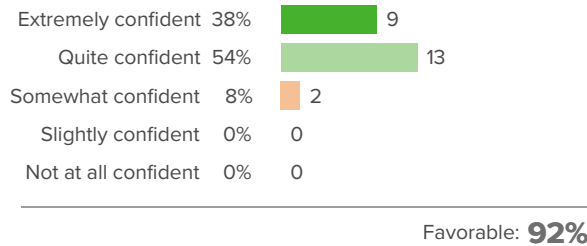

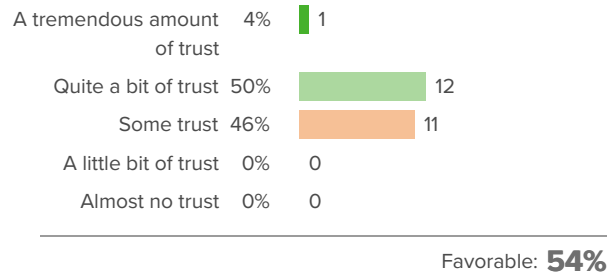

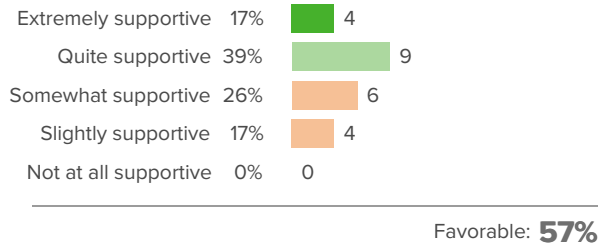

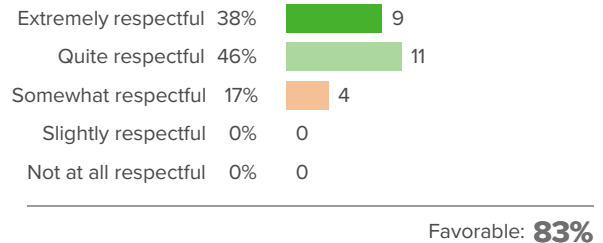
Q.2: How much trust exists between school leaders and faculty?



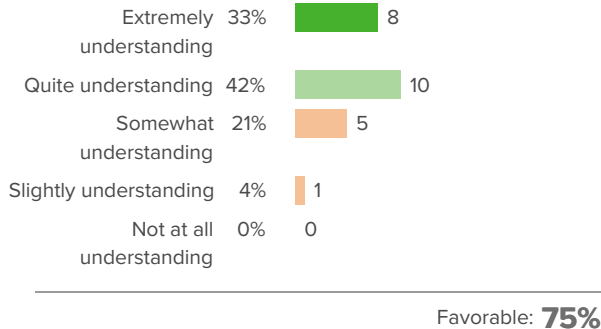
Q.3: When you face challenges at work, how supportive are your school leaders?



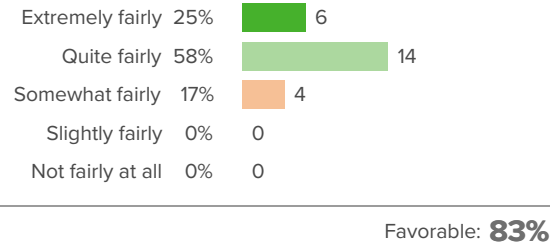

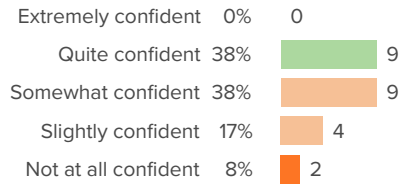

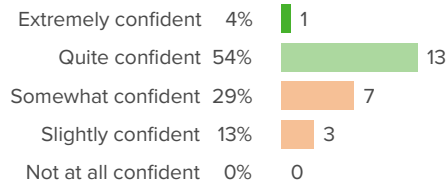

Q.1: How confident are you that you can move through material at a pace that works well for each of your students?



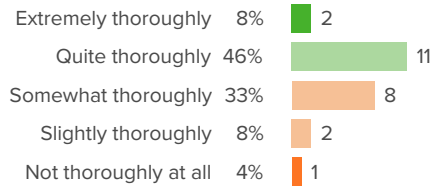

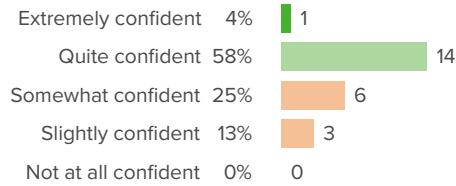

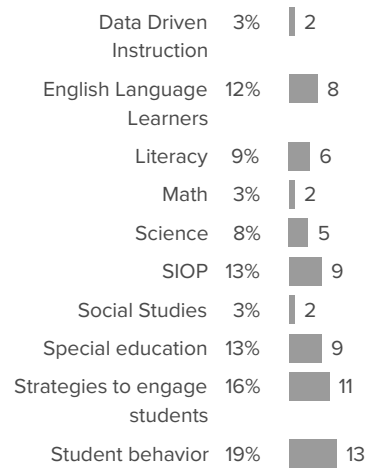

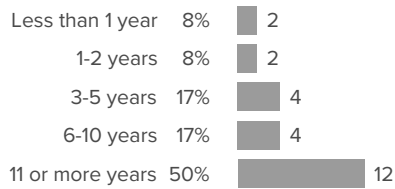
