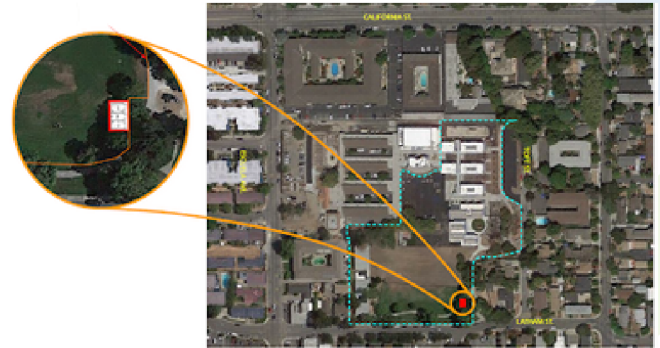

Measure T projects starting at Castro and Mistral Elementary Schools

Window installation is planned for May through August 2023. The work is a result of changes in state building codes for schools and to replace older windows. Construction will take place in the late afternoons and evenings during the school year and during business hours in the summer.

In August, the **field gates will be locked during the school day** as part of a new perimeter controls system. The specific date will be posted on signage at the gates. The public will continue to have access to school fields in the evenings and on weekends through a system of automatic locking/unlocking gates. For student and staff safety, it's very important for our school to limit points of entry during school hours.

A restroom building will be installed on the southeast corner of the field near the Latham Street tot lot. The standalone toilet building will be maintained by the City and may be used after school hours by the public; not by students during the school day.



Construction has been scheduled to minimize disruptions for students, staff and neighbors. Thank you in advance for your patience.
