Measure T projects starting at Castro and Mistral Elementary Schools

Window installation is planned for May through August 2023. The work is a result of changes in state building codes for schools and to replace older windows. Construction will take place in the late afternoons and evenings during the school year and during business hours in the summer.

In August, the field gates will be locked during **the school day** as part of a new perimeter controls system. The specific date will be posted on signage at the gates. The public will continue to have access to school fields in the evenings and on weekends through a system of automatic locking/unlocking gates. For student and staff safety, it's very important for our school to limit points of entry during school hours.
