Happening now: Multi-use room construction



Construction is underway on new multi-use rooms for these schools. The multi-use rooms will be 5,800 square feet with seating capacity for 225, including a performance stage.

Happening now: New school construction



Construction on the new Castro School, with new classrooms and a shared multi-use room, will continue in the 2017-18 year.

Monta Loma

Happening now: Multi-use room expansion



Classroom modernization, which began this summer, is finishing up. The multi-use room expansion will continue through December 2017.

Theuerkauf

In Spring/Summer: Multi-use room expansion



Theuerkauf's classroom modernization and multi-use room expansion projects will begin in April 2018, and work will take place over summer 2018.

Stevenson

Happening now: Site development and new construction

Stevenson projects include a new multi-use room, new library converted from the existing Board Room, new wings of classrooms, and new administrative offices. Construction on the new Stevenson campus will begin in

September and will continue through June 2018.









Crittenden

Happening now: Track & field



Work continues on the Permanente Creek Trail Extension Project, paid for by the City of Mountain View. The District is replacing the current playfields along Middlefield Road with a synthetic track and playfield and a smaller softball

field. Estimated completion date of winter 2017.

Slater

Happening now: Site development

District staff has begun site planning for the construction of the new 450-student Slater Elementary that will house kindergarten through fifth grade beginning in the 2019-2020 school year. Site work is scheduled to begin in

February/March.
