Perimeter controls



Last year, new fencing and gates were added in order to completely enclose campus and to match existing fencing. This summer, pending materials availability, a lock management system will be added to the gates. With the installation of the automatic locking/unlocking gates, the public will continue to have access to fields in the evenings and on weekends. The purpose of the perimeter controls is to secure campuses during school hours when students are present. Additionally, this winter, staff members will be able to access classrooms and offices using key cards, instead of keys.

Solar Installation



Solar panels will be installed in arrays on rooftops and on a structure over the auditorium parking lot on Rock Street. Solar panels will save the district \$600,000 annually in electrical costs. Fencing will be installed during the week of May 31 and will be in place until October/November 2022. There will be no parking in front of the auditorium during this time.



Lighting



New lights and/or bollard style light posts will be installed to illuminate pedestrians' path of travel between campus and parking lots. The light locations were determined by photometric survey data. This additional lighting is an important safety measure for staff members and guests using the campus in the evenings and winter late afternoons.

Electrical

The main breakers will be replaced as part of the school's electrical upgrade. Campus will be without power during this work.

HVAC

Aging HVAC units will be replaced.
The existing HVAC system has already been updated to include MERV-13 filters, which is the highest-grade filter available for our units.

Security Cameras

Security cameras in public areas will be installed at all school sites as a way to increase safety for students and staff members by deterring misconduct and preventing vandalism. Members of the schools' communities were engaged in a series of feedback meetings in Winter 2022.

Paving

Due to damage from adjacent trees, a section of the existing asphalt parking lot off Middlefield Rd will be removed and replaced to provide a flat, safe surface. We will try to save all trees but if the roots are too disrupted we may need to remove some of the trees. <u>During construction, there will be no car entrance off of Middlefield Road.</u> Sports Center parking will be accessible from Rock Street.
