Projects

- New Castro Elementary School
- Shared Multi-Use Room and Library

Timing

Through late fall 2018

What to expect this summer:

All of Castro and many of Mistral's teachers will pack and move to new classrooms this summer. Castro's new school will open to students in August 2018.

The current Castro/Mistral library, school office and other areas will be under construction this summer. Mistral's main entrance will move to the north.

The current Castro/Mistral multi-use room on Escuela will be torn down to make way for the Mistral kindergarten wing construction. The new kinder wing is scheduled to be complete in late fall 2018.

Additionally, Escuela Avenue in front of the school will undergo construction as part of a separate City of Mountain View project. The Escuela parking lot will be renovated to increase traffic flow and improve safety. Please expect no access to the school offices, classrooms and Escuela parking lot this summer. There will be the sound of beeping from trucks, and likely work on Saturdays.
