

Dear Neighbor,

Thanks to the generosity of our community, Monta Loma's Measure G construction project will begin this summer. Passed by voters in 2012, Measure G generates funding to provide safe, efficient, and modern facilities for Mountain View Whisman School District students and staff.

Classroom modernization will be complete in August 2017. The Multi-Use Room expansion will continue through late October 2017. During the Summer of 2018, roofing and renovation of the staff and office areas will be completed.

This summer, crews will be demolishing four classrooms, remodeling student restrooms, adding two portable buildings, installing a fire lane, and expanding and remodeling the kitchen. The Multi-Use Room will be expanded beginning May 1, 2017. Classrooms will be modernized with technology upgrades, new teaching walls, and fire alarm replacements. The parking lots and student drop off zone also will be improved.

What to expect this summer:

Containers for storage of furniture and classroom materials will be delivered in May and set up on campus (see map). The kitchen has been dismantled (students' meals will be served from the MUR for the remainder of the year) to prepare for the start of the MUR renovation.

Temporary utilities will be installed in the back of the campus in mid-May. At that time, you may notice construction trailers and fencing materials on campus.

After school dismissal on June 6, fencing will go up and construction begins. Please expect that areas of the campus and occasionally the play structures will be off-limits this summer.
